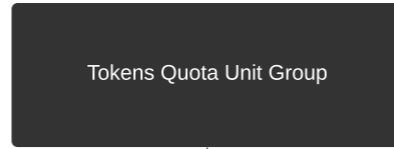


You create a quota unit group, called Tokens. A quota unit group contains one or more quota units.



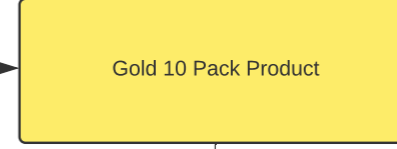
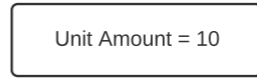
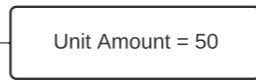
You create a quota unit, called Silver and attach it to the Tokens quota unit group.



You create a quota unit, called Gold and attach it to the Tokens quota unit group.

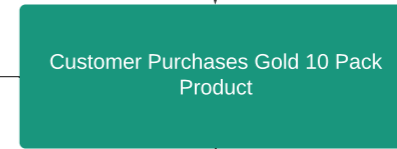
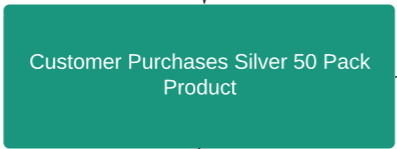


You create a product called Silver 50 Pack and attach the Silver Quota Unit to it. You set the unit amount to 50.



You create a product called Gold 10 Pack and attach the Gold Quota Unit to it. You set the unit amount to 10.

A new customer signs up with your service and purchases both silver and gold token products.

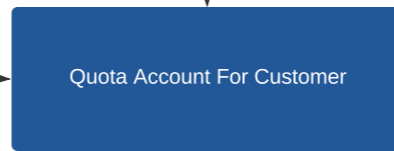
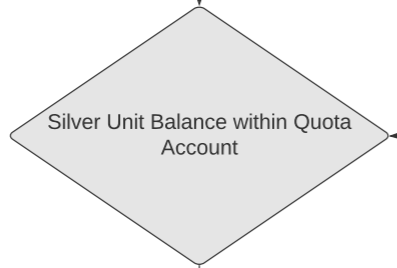

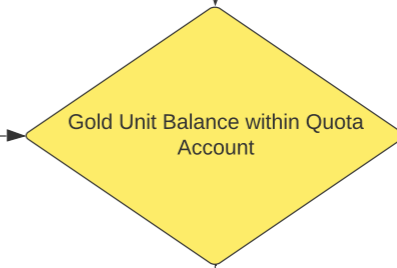

A balance for the Silver Unit is kept within the customers' quota account.



A balance for the Gold Unit is kept within the customers' quota account.



A quota account is created for a new customer or if an existing customer does not have a quota account for the parent quota unit group. If the customer exists and has a quota account a new account would not be created.

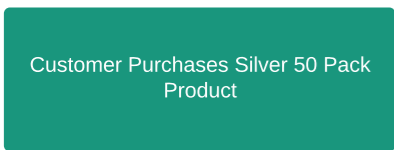
